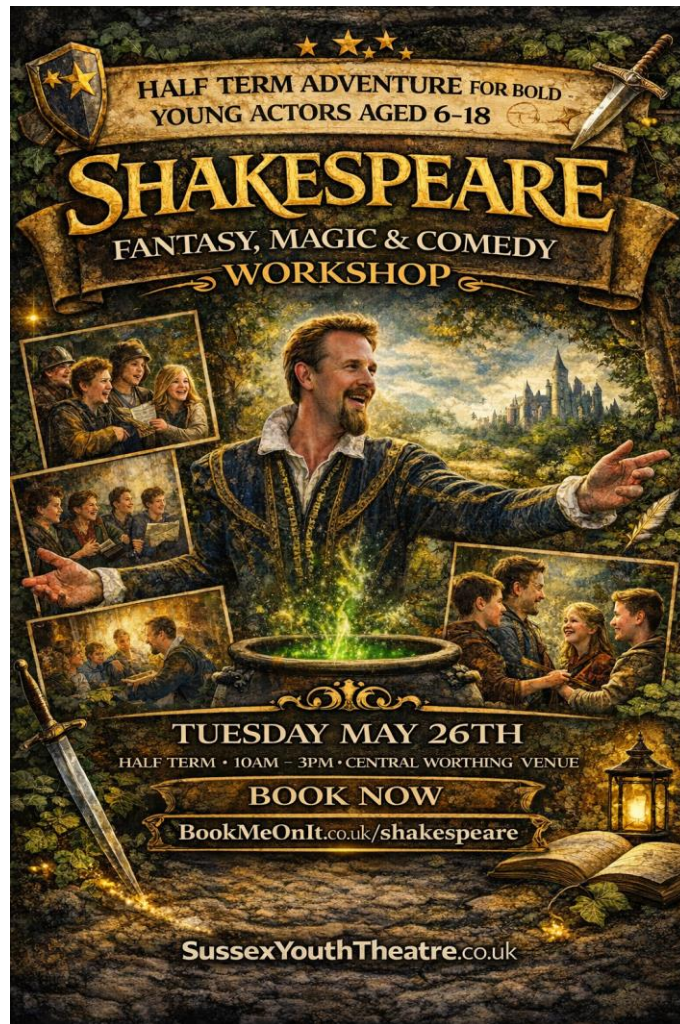

WHAT STUDENTS WILL LEARN

This is professional actor training adapted for young performers:

- How to speak Shakespeare's verse with clarity and confidence
- The rhythm of iambic pentameter (and why it matters)
- The difference between verse and prose
- How to colour language and play emotion
- Status, humour and character relationships
- Soliloquy technique – bringing thoughts to life
- Physical storytelling and ensemble work
- Focus, trust and performance discipline
- How to approach Shakespeare for auditions, LAMDA or GCSE

Students won't just read scenes — they will:

- Stage them
- Reinterpret them
- Perform them

The day finishes with a Q&A, giving students the chance to ask about training, acting and working professionally.
